Emeritus Professor Nigel Groome's generosity and vision were instrumental in founding and developing the Nagarjun Learning Centre in Saldum village, Dhading, Nepal. From 2019 until June 2025, he contributed over £50,000, most of it via Help for Nepal, transforming unused village land into a vibrant community learning centre.

His support funded the construction of the centre, educational materials including computers and internet access, and programmes that created a safe, welcoming space for both children and adults. Over six years, literacy classes, computer training, and community workshops reached hundreds of people.
